

**2006 Herding Clinic at Gefion Hall

In Pawling NY**

Come join us for a herding clinic with **Tenley Dexter**. Tenley has been involved in training and trialing for over 17 years with multiple dogs including ASCA WTCH Beauwood's Kobi CD HAsd (Aussie), WTCH C Hangin' 5 Annie's Breeze HAsd (Aussie), WTCH Makin' 8 Kate (Kelpie), WTCH Makin' 8 Tuff E Nuff HIs (Aussie), and WTCH Makin' 8 Seeing Stars HIs (Aussie). She has bred, trained and qualified multiple dogs for the ASCA Stockdog Finals and participates in ASCA, AKC, AHBA and BC trials. Her students have multiple breeds.

Tenley will be at Gefion Hall May 6th and 7th, 2006

The clinic will be full days beginning at 8 am.

Weather and time permitting, each participant will work their dog twice per day.

Working spots are limited to 12 participants per day.

Unlimited Auditor spots are available

This clinic is open to all herding levels and all herding breeds.

Gefion Hall facilities include a wide range of pen and field sizes.

Spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis by postmark. **Pre-Entry only**

Water and shade available; bring your own crates and chairs.

Beverages, light snacks, and lunch provided.

Working spot \$150 (2 days)

Auditor spot \$30 per day

Please be considerate of the rules:

Dogs must be current on their vaccinations, including rabies, and must be worm-free.

Be considerate of the neighbors; do not allow your dogs to bark continuously.

Clean up after your dogs. Receptacles will be provided.

Dogs are not allowed to disturb or harass the horses.

Dogs must be on leash when not working.

No videotaping allowed.

From the west: take 84 E to Exit 18 (Patterson-Carmel Lake). Go left onto 311 going North. Follow 311 approximately 5 miles, to Rte 22. Go left on Rte 22 (North) through Pawling. **You will pass Route 55. In the town of Pawling you will pass Rte 67 (with a light). After this, look for Martin's Sheds and Gazebos on the right. At this landmark, look for Rte 68 (North Quaker Hill Rd.) in approximately 0.7 miles, which heads off to the right. Note that there are 3 Quaker Hill Rds off of 22, so make sure you take North Quaker Hill Rd (Rte 68). Turn right on Rte 68, (there is no light), proceed to the T intersection and take another right to continue on Rte 68. Go approximately 1.6 miles and turn right onto Strawberry Hill, which is at the top of a hill. Strawberry Hill will make a sharp right and then a sharp left hand turn in front of Gefion Hall. Please use the barn entrance, which is the second entrance on the right, situated between two paddocks. Please park in the lot near the big red barn.

From the east: take Rte 684 or Sawmill Parkway directly to Rte 22 North to Pawling. Once on Rte 22 stay on this and follow directions from ** above.
