

Jan Wesen Herding Clinic at Gefion Hall, in Pawling NY
April 23, 24, and 25th, 2010

Come join us for a Jan Wesen herding clinic. Jan was raised on a dairy farm, and after obtaining a B.S. in Dairy Science she married Ron Wesen, moved to Bow, WA, and continued her life on a working dairy farm. Kelpie's and Aussie's came into her life when she wanted a farm dog that could also play the versatile dog game. She believes that doing obedience and working stock puts it all together for a well-rounded dog. She now works with Aussie's in all venues and enjoys working with them on a daily basis. She currently has both Australian Kelpies and Australian Shepherds, and trains and competes in herding, obedience, tracking, agility and flyball. She teaches both herding and obedience to her students. She has over 17 years experience with her Kelpies, and has competed in Australian Shepherd Club of America, American Kennel Club, American Herding Breed Association, Working Kelpie Inc. as well as Border Collie trials. She is an ASCA, AKC, CKC and AHBA herding judge. She and her husband work their dogs on their 500-cow dairy farm where chores such as bringing cows in for milking, holding gates, and sorting are accomplished on a daily basis. Jan's background on the farm and trialing has increased her awareness of the importance of having a well-trained dog. She believes that the more advanced the dog's training, the better one can do in trials and the more work can be done on the farm. She is continually working to improve her techniques with her dogs, as well as teaching others to work with their dogs. Jan works with all herding breeds and all levels of handler and dog experience.

From the west: take 84 E to Exit 18 (Patterson-Carmel Lake). Go left onto 311 going North. Follow 311 approximately 5 miles, to Rte 22. Go left on Rte 22 (North) through Pawling. ****You will pass Route 55. In the town of Pawling you will pass Rte 67 (with a light). After this, look for Martin's Sheds and Gazebos on the right. At this landmark, look for Rte 68 (North Quaker Hill Rd.) in approximately 0.7 miles, which heads off to the right. Note that there are 3 Quaker Hill Rds off of 22, so make sure you take North Quaker Hill Rd (Rte 68). Turn right on Rte 68, (there is no light), proceed to the T intersection and take another right to continue on Rte 68. Go approximately 1.6 miles and turn right onto Strawberry Hill, which is at the top of a hill. Strawberry Hill will make a sharp right and then a sharp left hand turn in front of Gefion Hall. Please use the barn entrance, which is the second entrance on the right, situated between two paddocks. Please park in the lot near the big red barn.**

From the east: take Rte 684 or Sawmill Parkway directly to Rte 22 North to Pawling. Once on Rte 22 stay on this and follow directions from ****** above.

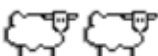
