Diane provides a step by step positive approach using pressure & release to get you & your dog working as a team. Build a relationship with your dog, build interest, teach the dog to work calmly with stock, learn or fine-tune herding commands. Learn by watching others work their dogs. Participants will each have an opportunity to work stock 2 times per day. Most participants see marked improvements over the 2-day clinic.

Pre-Entry only. Limited to 12 working spots (dog/handler teams). Unlimited auditor spots available. This is a 2-day working clinic.

Stock available: Mixed breed hair sheep.

Please fill out the attached entry form and attach your check (payable to Nancy Liptak – all checks will be cashed prior to the clinic, with all funds donated to the Renn family.)

Cost: \$175/ working spot for both days. One day working spot \$100. Auditor registration is \$50 per day. If you register for a working spot, but are unable to attend, your money will be refunded to you if your spot can be filled.

Restrictions: This is a private farm, please be considerate. Dogs must be on leash or penned, tied, or crated when not working, and must not be allowed to bark continuously, harass the livestock or interfere with the team that is currently working.

Other:

- Please bring your own lunch, drinks, and snacks.
- Water/pools will be available for cooling dogs off.
- Please bring your own shade, chairs and crates.
- Dress in layers & wear appropriate footwear.

About the Instructor:

Diane Sobel-Meyer has been instructing all breed classes & privates for many different venues, for over 25 years. Her main philosophy in dog training is: KEEP AN OPEN MIND, NO 2 DOGS ARE ALIKE, and USE WHAT WORKS FOR YOUR DOG!

Diane has competed with her dogs in advanced levels in obedience, agility, & herding. She is also currently training dogs for Search & Rescue work. Diane's dog, "Magnum", has passed his Type I advanced disaster test for the NJ State Police Urban Search & Rescue team.

In herding, she has worked cattle, sheep, & ducks with her dogs. Her dogs have earned multiple High In Trials, High Combined (working different stock) & Most Promising Started Dogs. Her dog Déjà vu's The Dance, STDsc, HS, CD, RS-E, JS-E, GS-O, OA, EAC, EJC, OGC, "Kylie" was High In Trial on sheep at the USASA 1998 National Specialty. Her dog WTCH Hangin Tree Devil of Déjà vu, RTDsc, HRDIII, HXAs "Reba", placed in the top 10, in sheep & ducks at the ASCA National Stock Finals in 2003.

Magnum, WTCH Ad Astra Magnum Force, RTDcs, placed 5th in Most Versatile Aussie at the 2007 ASCA Nationals, out of 82 dogs.

Diane is also an AHBA judge.
